The City Council of Cáceres, through the Department of Citizen Participation, was present in Rome at the III meeting of the Trans-lighthouses Consortium, which took place on February 28, 29 and March 1.

"This is an international event, which we attended for the first time as guests to participate in a round table dedicated to citizen participation and governance," explained Ceballos, adding that "I have had the great opportunity to showcase and share the Citizen Participation model that is being developed in Cáceres and to also learn about the working methods of the municipal corporations of Roma, Estarreja and Barcelos in Portugal and Brussels."

Over the course of several days, participants shared programs closely linked to environmental sustainability, the main objective of the Trans-lighthouses project. This European Union-funded plan comprises 16 partner organizations, "among which Cáceres could join in the not-too-distant future," and integrates pilot projects offering nature-based solutions for the community.

As part of this initiative, "Cáceres has the possibility of integrating and becoming part of this Consortium through a pilot project focused on composting and organic waste management, after appropriate analysis and advice," highlighted the councilor, who thanked them for the invitation as it has allowed her to "learn firsthand about other systems of citizen
